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The B27 allele group of the HLA-B locus is present in 2 to 9% of the general US population. About 20% of the HLA-B27 carriers develop autoimmune disorders, including Ankylosing Spondylitis (AS), Reactive Arthritis, Psoriatic Arthritis, Undifferentiated Oligoarthritis, Uveitis, or Inflammatory Bowel Disease. The highest association is with AS, where approximately 95% of AS patients are HLA-B27 positive.

Low resolution HLA typings are routinely performed by PCR-rSSO or PCR-SSP methodologies.

These tests were developed and their performance characteristics determined by BloodCenter of Wisconsin. They have not been cleared by the FDA. However, this approval is not required.
